



RE-OPENING PROTOCOLS – June 11, 2021

- In fall 2020, Door Community Auditorium's HVAC system was upgraded by Gibraltar Schools. Ionization bars were installed within the air handlers and outside air damper (fresh air) was increased. Filters in the HVAC system were upgraded from Merv 7 to 13
- All advance sales tickets will be mailed rather than held at the box office to reduce face to face contact and close proximity queuing
- 10 hands-free hand-sanitizing stations were purchased and are placed strategically around the facility
- For the foreseeable future, masks will be required for everyone on site over the age of five including patrons, staff, volunteers, crew, caterers and performing artists (except when removed as required for performance)
- Playbills and programs will be available as electronic, not print, documents.
- Performances will last about 70 minutes and include no intermissions, no merchandise signing, no concessions, nor artist meet and greets
- We will reduce volunteer crew to an essential skeleton crew to reduce number of individuals on site for any event
- We are urging all staff and volunteers to be vaccinated. DCA board has discussed--but not acted upon--this being required.
- Barring a CDC/Wisconsin Department of Health guideline change, from June 22 thru August 7, ticketing capacity will be restricted to 25%, or 190 seats. Beginning August 8, we plan to increase our capacity to 60%, or 456 seats as some shows are planned at that point in the summer that would break even only at about 90% capacity (we are prepared to shoulder some financial loss this year, but need to come closer to covering high artist fees and production costs to remain viable.)
